Teacher	5

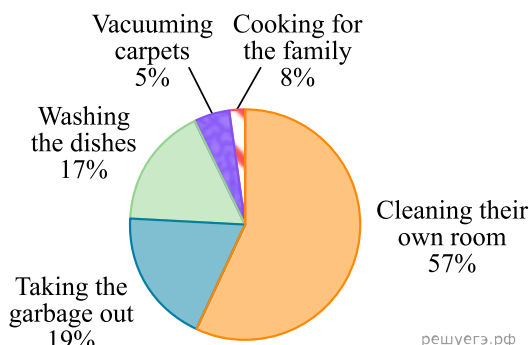
