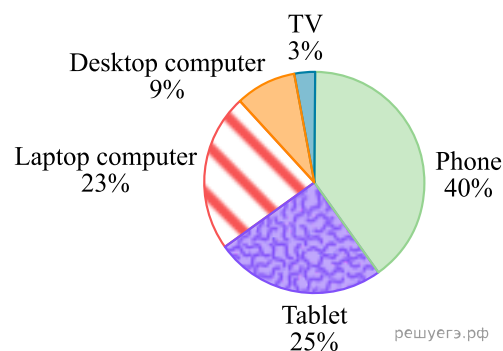
Use the following plan:
